

In Loving Memory of Frank "Buzz" Harrison



For decades, Baptist Campus Ministry has been *Changing Lives that Change the World* on college campuses throughout West Virginia. Tens of thousands of students have heard the gospel. Thousands have been discipled. Students from more than a hundred different countries have experienced the love of Christ first-hand. But none of that would have been possible without the help of the first Executive Director of BCM, Frank "Buzz" Harrison.

When he accepted the call to lead BCM in its infancy in 1974, Buzz didn't know how many lives he would impact. Fresh off a tour in Vietnam where he served as an Army doctor, Buzz began his work at Fairmont State College and ministered on nine different campuses across the state. His goal was to "encourage students to grow in their faith, apply it in real life and ensure that every decision included Jesus." He also placed a high priority on relationships, understanding that investment took time.

Stand in any of WVBC's 350+ churches and throw a stone—you're bound to hit someone whose life has been changed thanks to BCM and Buzz's work in ministry. Many pastors,

teachers and current leaders of BCM sat under Buzz's teaching in his ten years as Executive Director and saw him as a mentor and friend.

Buzz went home to be with the Lord on Christmas Day 2024. Our hearts grieve with Buzz's family and loved ones but we rejoice that Buzz is in the presence of the Father.
